**NEW BUSINESS:**

President Cortez provided an update and clarification about the “Work from Home” report an example of the items that should be included. We are only one of two districts in the state not to have a COVID-19 MOU already signed with the college. We are bringing safety and pay issues forward, as well as pushing for a formal process for essential workers and more transparency into the re-opening procedures/protocols. Working to have two separate MOU’s, one that covers until June 30, 2020 and a second that extends from July 1st to December 30, 2020.

Issues that were raised by the membership to include in the MOU language were as follows; covering immune compromised members, those that care for elder/immune compromised individuals and childcare telework options until safety can be ensured.

There appears to be no formal plan from the district in how they are handling essential workers, while the district is maintaining they are following Monterey County Health guidelines, concerns remain. If you are required to go to campus/college you should have received a "Return to Work" letter from HR, if not, and you have asked to come to campus by your supervisor, please let the eboard know immediately via e-mail.

There is an Administrative Services Meeting at 1pm today looking at budget cuts. Belen gave an update and noted that working groups have been formed and that one of the items was medical benefits. Additionally, that a public available spreadsheet of items under consideration was available for all to review.
